Resolution Proclaiming March 2-6, 2010 as
WEEK OF THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, approximately 15,000 certificated and classified school administrators work in California's public schools, including about 60 in the Santa Rosa City Schools; and

WHEREAS, nearly 60 percent of these administrators are principals, vice-principals and assistant principals providing direct support for educational programs at school sites; and

WHEREAS, research has determined that one of the main attributes of effective schools is the competent leadership of principals; and

WHEREAS, other certificated and classified administrators provide leadership and support for the educational programs; and

WHEREAS, research shows that efficient district-level administration improves teacher effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, research shows that public school administration in California has become increasingly efficient and effective, with fewer administrators managing more schools with more pupils than in the past; and

WHEREAS, a school's administrative team includes confidential employees who perform and assist in the performance of many critical functions; and

WHEREAS, school administrators and confidential employees ensure that effective and innovative classroom instruction is promoted in every area of California;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the week of March 2 through March 6, 2010, be proclaimed the Week of the School Administrator in the Santa Rosa City Schools as it has been by the State Legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the administrators of the Santa Rosa City Schools be commended for their support of, and contributions to, quality education.
